




International Summer School (cont'd)

- Select candidates from
 - Croatia and Bosnia & Herzegovina
- Shalom-Salam Plus program
 - 1 week at NAL, Lillehammer, followed by
 - 6 weeks at ISS, Oslo
- Total cost estimated € 4 500 per student
 - Travel & Accomodation
 - NAL/ISS fees
 - Pocket Money
- Future increase # of students as interest grows
